1. Often /'ɒf.ən/ /'ɒf.tən/ (adv): thường
2. Never /'nev.ər/ (adv): không bao giờ
3. Sometimes /'sʌm.taɪmz/ (adv): thỉnh thoảng
4. Always /'ɔ:l.weɪz/ (adv): luôn luôn
5. Rarely /'rer.li/ (adv): hiếm khi
6. Usually /'ju:ʒu.ə.li/ (adv): thường xuyên

II. Grammar:

Adverbs of Frequency

We use the **adverbs of frequency** to talk about how often we do things or how often things happen.
In a sentence, we often put the adverbs of frequency after the verb "be" or before the main verb.

I **usually** play soccer on **the weekends**.

He/She **sometimes** plays soccer on **Saturdays**.

I **never** go shopping.

He/She **rarely** goes shopping.

How often do you **play soccer**?

How often does he/she **play soccer**?

To talk about regular actions, use **always** and **usually** with a time phrase.

e.g. *I always play soccer.* (✗)

I always play soccer on Saturdays. (✓)
