Demonstratives & Object Pronouns

+ Demonstratives: We use this/that/these/those to show which things we are talking about.

For things close to the speaker		For things further away	
Singular nouns	Plural nouns	Singular nouns	Plural nouns
this How much is <i>this</i> T-shirt?	these How much are <i>these</i> T-shirts?	that How much is <i>that</i> T-shirt over there?	those How much are <i>those</i> T-shirts over there?

+ Object Pronouns – it/them: We use object pronouns after a verb or a preposition.

	Object pronouns	Examples
Singular nouns	it	I like <i>this</i> jacket. Do you have <i>it</i> in blue?
Plural nouns	them	I like <i>these</i> pants. Can I try <i>them</i> on?

Demonstratives

We use **this/that/these/those** to show which things we are talking about.

This/That: for singular nouns

These/Those: for plural nouns

This/These: for things close to the speaker

That/Those: for things further away

How much is **this** T-shirt?

Do you have **that** shirt in blue?

How much are **those** shoes over there?

Do you have **these** socks in green?

Object Pronouns: **it** / **them**

We use **Object Pronouns** after a verb or a preposition.

We use **it** for singular nouns and **them** for plural nouns.

I like this jacket. Do you have **it** in blue?

I like these pants. Can I try **them** on?
