We (Jack and I) <b>live</b> in the city. You (you and your family/friends) <b>live</b> in the city. They (Jack and his friends) <b>live</b> in the city.	I <b>don't live</b> in an apartment. You <b>don't live</b> in a house. He (Jack) <b>doesn't live</b> in the city. She (Jack's aunt) <b>doesn't live</b> in the country. It (Jack's apartment) <b>doesn't have</b> a balcony. We (Jack and I) <b>don't live</b> in the city. You (you and your family/friends) <b>don't live</b> in the city. They (Jack and his friends) <b>don't live</b> in the city.

Yes/No questions	Positive answers	Negative answers
Do you <b>live</b> in a house?	Yes, I <b>do</b> .	No, I <b>don't</b> .
Does he (Jack) <b>live</b> in the city?	Yes, he <b>does</b> .	No, he <b>doesn't</b> .
Does she (Jack's aunt) <b>live</b> in the country?	Yes, she <b>does</b> .	No, she <b>doesn't</b> .
Does it (Jack's apartment) <b>have</b> a balcony?	Yes, it <b>does</b> .	No, it <b>doesn't</b> .
Do you (you and your family/friends) <b>live</b> in the city?	Yes, we <b>do</b> .	No, we <b>don't</b> .
Do they (Jack and his friends) <b>live</b> in the city?	Yes, they <b>do</b> .	No, they <b>don't</b> .
