A. CLAUSES AFTER WISH

Ex: She wanted to have more time to know Viet Nam better. She might say

→ "I **wish** I had more time to know Viet Nam better..."

FORM: S₁ + **wish(es)** + S₂ + **Past simple tense**

S + V2/ V-ed (Negative: S + **didn't** + V (base form))

Be ⇨ was, were (not be ⇨ wasn't, weren't)

→ To express wish (something unlikely to happen)

B. Used to + infinitive (đã từng, thói quen ở quá khứ)

Be **used to/ get used to** + V-ing: quen với, thích nghi với

EX:

I **used to play** soccer but I don't play anymore.

I **am used to playing** rugby in the cold. I am accustomed to it.

I **get used playing** rugby in the cold.
