Grammar

1. The present simple with Wh-questions

Wh-question word + do + subject (you, we, they, plural noun) + bare infinitive?

Examples:

What **do you do** in your free time?

Where **do you live** in this city?

When **do you clean** the kitchen?

Who **do you usually do** the shopping with?

Wh-question word + does + subject (he, she, it/singular noun) + bare infinitive?

Examples:

What **does Ken (he) do** in his free time?

Where **does Jenny (she) live** in this city?

When **does your sister clean** the kitchen?

Who **does your brother usually do** the shopping with?

+ Possession – 's

We don't often say:

• She is the mother of Ken.

• He is the father of Joe.

• They are notebooks of Marry.

We should say:

→ She is **Ken's mother**.

→ He is **Joe's father**.

→ They are **Mary's notebooks**.
