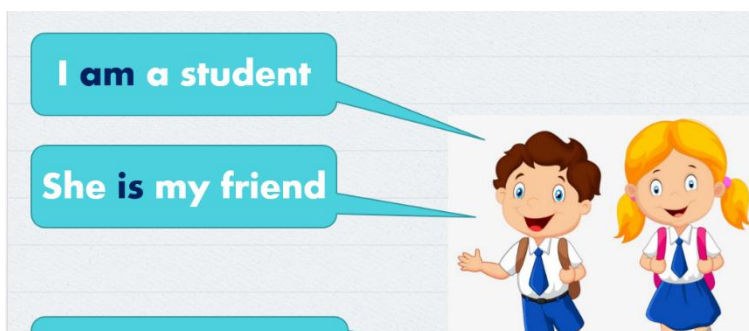

+ **Where:** is used when referring to a place or location. (= I want to know the place)

Where + to be + subject?

→ **S + be + (place)**

Example:

Where are the students? → They are in the classroom.

+ **What:** is used to refer to specific information. (= I want to know the thing)

What + to be + subject?

→ **S + to be + (thing)**

Example:

What is your name? → My name is Mary.

+ **Who:** is only used to refer to ask a person. (= I want to know a person.)

Who + to be + subject?

→ **S + to be + (person)**

Example:

Who is he? → He is my older brother.

2. Conjunctions: or/but/and.

- Conjunctions are used to connect two sentences into one long sentence.

+ **"And":** is used to add items to a list.

Example: I am from Vietnam **and** I am a student.

+ **"Or":** is used to talk about options.

You can have the blue pen **or** the red pen.

+ **"But":** is used to show contrast.

Example:

I can speak English, **but** I am not very good at it.
