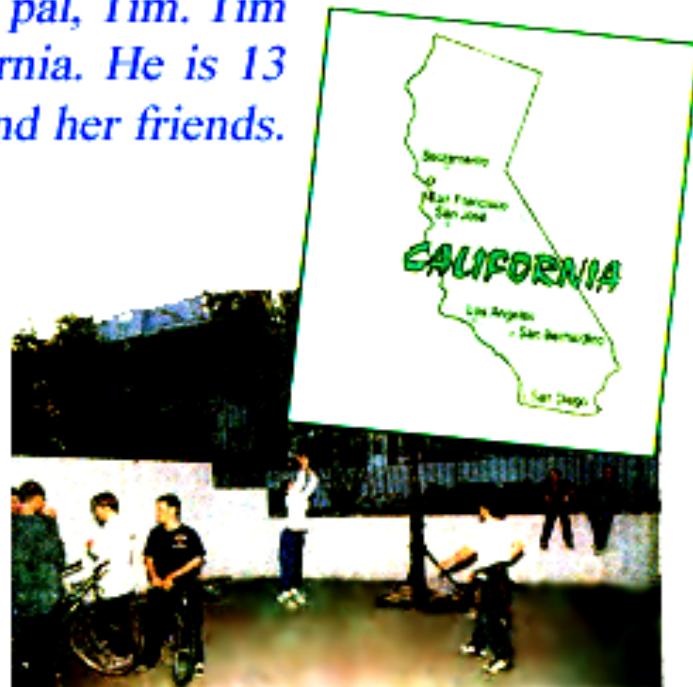
### 3 Read. Then answer the questions

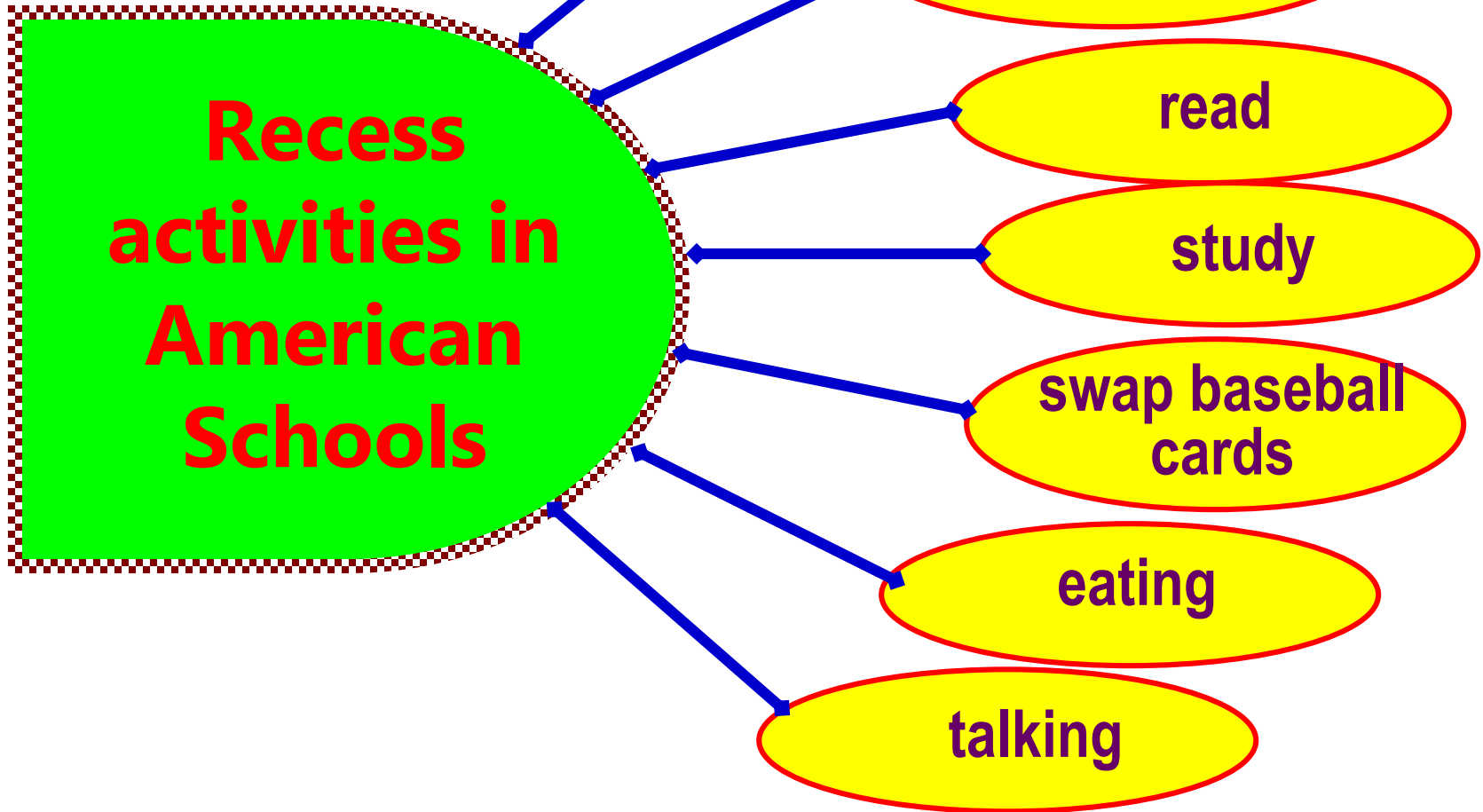
