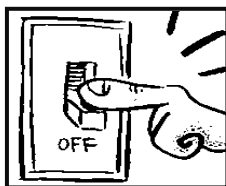

Finally, on Tuesday, December 9, the wind came and the fog went away. But after that, even more people got sick. Many of them died.
